Topic: Disposal of Surplus Goods

Purpose: To advise Council of equipment considered surplus to the needs of the Township and request authorization for appropriate disposal.

Background: The items listed below are deemed surplus to Township needs:

| Fire | Honda EM 5000 S Generator (not working) |
| Fire | Scott self contained breathing apparatus & cylinders x 4 |
| Fire/ES | Scott self contained breathing apparatus & cylinders x 4 |
| Fire | 10 HP Gorman-Rupp Portable pump (30 years old) |
| Fire | Hale Portable pump (50 years old) |


Policy Implications: By-Law 2015-57 permits surplus items to be disposed of through public auction, sealed bid or trade-in. The items will be sold as is, where is and without any warranty or guarantee.

Financial Considerations: The government auction would be the most economical means of disposal of the PW and fire department trucks. The trucks could be sold as is/where is, as opposed to paying for shipment offsite. The SCBA are also a good fit for the government auction as this type of equipment is routinely sold via their website.


Options:
